SOMETHING

- Pursuant to Act 44 of 2018, the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General (OAG) is establishing the "Safe2Say Something" (S2SS) school safety anonymous tip program.
- S2SS allows individuals to submit secure and anonymous safety concerns to help identify and intervene when unsafe and/or harmful behaviors take place within K-12 schools statewide.
- Tips are submitted via the app, website, or through our dedicated hotline, and each tip is reviewed by the S2SS crisis center housed in the Office of Attorney General.
- The call center will process and refer each tip to the appropriate school teams and law enforcement according to the level of threat.
- This program is mandated by law to be live, accepting tips, and forwarding tips to the appropriate school entity on January 14, 2019.

HOW will my district be trained?

- **S2SS Lead and Team Members:** In-person training for lead and 2-4 other team members (Lead: 1 hour/Lead and Team 2 Hours)
- **Students:** Use interactive training video or, if timing allows, use of SHP Trainers to deliver via classroom or auditorium style (1 hour) **ALL SCHOOLS** (public and private) will need to train students in grades 6-12.
- **Parents/Educators and Administrators:** Materials/video provided to schools for education of school admin/educators as well as parents/caretakers (30 minutes)

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
