Instructional Certificates

24 post baccalaureate credits*

3 years of satisfactory service on the Pennsylvania Level I certificate (all areas will convert simultaneously);

Completion of a PDE-approved induction program (certificates issued on or after June 1, 1987); and

Satisfactory results on PDE 427 Level II assessment (certificates issued on or after September 1, 2001).

*Educators issued an Instructional I certificate <u>after September 22, 2007</u> must complete 6 specific credit hours as a part of the 24 semester hour post-baccalaureate credits. Therefore, <u>effective September 1, 2011</u>, individuals applying for Level II conversion must have earned at least six post-baccalaureate credits of collegiate study in the area of **Inclusive Classrooms** and/or in the area of **Standards Aligned Systems (SAS)**. **To clarify**, the Bureau of School Leadership & Teacher Quality will review Level II apps <u>after September 1, 2011</u>, based on the following:

The inclusion credits will only be required for individuals who received their initial Instructional I certification <u>after September 22, 2007</u>. If your initial certificate was issued <u>before</u> this date, this requirement will not affect you even if you apply after September 1, 2011.

If an individual was issued their initial Instructional I <u>before September 22, 2007</u> and has added other areas on to their certificate <u>after</u> that date, this requirement will not affect them since they were initially certified <u>before September 22, 2007</u>.

If an individual received their initial Instructional I <u>after September 22, 2007</u>, and is applying for Level II <u>after September 1, 2011</u>, and they have completed only 21 of their 24 credits <u>before September 1, 2011</u>, they only need to take the remaining 3 credits in Inclusion or SAS.

Educational Specialist Certificates

24 post baccalaureate credits;

3 years of satisfactory service in each conversion area requested;

Completion of a PDE-approved induction program (certificates issued on or after September 1, 2001); and

Satisfactory results on PDE 427 Level II assessment (certificates issued on or after September 1, 2001).

Administrative/Supervisory Certificates

Certificate Type Code 83 and Type Code 81:

3 years of satisfactory service on the PA Administrative I or Supervisory I certificate in each administrative/supervisory area to be converted; if employed as a principal or assistant/vice principal in a public school for the first time after January 1, 2008, completion of the PIL Induction is also required.

Certificate Type Code 78:

If employed as a principal or assistant/vice principal prior to January 1, 2008, no additional requirements (certificate is valid for 99 years). If employed as a principal or assistant/vice principal in a public school for the first time on or after January 1, 2008, certificate holders must complete a Principal's Induction Program within five years of service.

Certificate Type Code 75:

Individuals who are employed for the first time in a position of Principal or Assistant Principal/Vice Principal in a Public school on or after January 1, 2008, must have 3 years of satisfactory service on the PA Administrative I certificate, and must complete a Principal's Induction Program with *five years of service*.

Program Specialist Certificates

Type Code 86: 3 years of satisfactory service on the Instructional I and/or Program Specialist Certificates and educator may convert.

Vocational Instructional Certificates

60 credit hours in an approved program in the appropriate field of vocational education*;

3 years of satisfactory service on the Pennsylvania Vocational Level I certificate attested to by the chief school administrator of the Pennsylvania-approved public, nonpublic or vocational-technical school entity in which the vocational teaching was completed; Completion of a PDE-approved induction program;

Passing scores on the appropriate Praxis Series exam(s) for Pennsylvania; and

Recommendation from an approved Pennsylvania university (Temple, Penn State, or Indiana University of Pennsylvania).

*Educators issued a Vocational Instructional Level I certificate on or after January 1, 2013 may be recommended for Vocational Instructional Level II certification by their PA approved preparatory college/university after completing a total of 60 credit hours in addition to the 18 credits earned in Voc I programs, including: at least six (6) credits or 180 hours, or an equivalent combination thereof, regarding accommodations and adaptations for students with disabilities in an inclusive setting; at least three (3) credits or 90 hours, or an equivalent combination thereof, in teaching English Language Learners.
